But those who do what is true come to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that their deeds have been done in God.'

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life.' As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.' Jesus said to them, 'The light is with you for a little longer. Walk while you have the light, so that the darkness may not overtake you. If you walk in the darkness, you do not know where you are going. While you have the light, believe in the light, so that you may become children of light.'

After Jesus had said this, he departed and hid from them. I have come as light into the world, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in the darkness.


